

## Indian Lake Park

Indian Lake Park is a 177-acre park which is located just southwest of Farmington, Iowa at the crossroads of Highways 2 and 81. It is the perfect retreat for a relaxing, back-to-nature experience. A 44-acre no-wake lake offers a peaceful setting for fishing, canoeing, or paddle-boating.



A two mile interpretive trail encompasses the lake, and is ideal for hiking, biking, and cross country skiing. There are seven cabins for rent, and primitive camping is also available. There are twelve full hookup sites, and more than 20 electric only sites available for RV's and campers. There is a shower house available, as well. Fishing and hunting licenses are also available for purchase at the Park.



Throughout the park you will find a wide variety of trees and foliage. Along the interpretive trail, turkey and white tail deer can be seen, as well.



There is truly something for everyone at Indian Lake Park. From camping, bird-watching, or canoeing to fishing, hiking, or picnicking, the activities are numerous.



Peaceful and scenic, Indian Lake park is a beautiful place for spending time outdoors.

The historic stone lodge is an ideal location for family reunions and get-togethers. The lodge may be rented on a daily basis.

## Available Accommodations & Park Regulations

### Cabins #1 and #2 ~

Wood built cabins, each containing 1 double bed and a futon which folds out into a double bed.



These cabins rent for \$45.00 per night, plus tax

### Cabins #3, #4, #5, and #6 ~

Renovated construction trailers.



Cabins #4 and #5 contain 2 sets of twin bunks  
Cabins #3 and #6 contain 1 set of twin bunks and a double bed

These cabins rent for \$30.00 per night, plus tax

Each cabin has a furnace, air conditioner, and a deck facing the lake. Each cabin also contains a stove, a full-sized refrigerator, and a bathroom with a shower. A coffee pot and toaster are provided in each kitchen, along with some dishes and cooking utensils.

Cabins 1-6 all accommodate up to 4 people.

### Cabins #7 & #8 ~

Renovated Mobile Home Trailers.

Three bedrooms, one and a half baths, full size kitchen

These cabins rents for \$50.00 per night, plus tax for up to 2 people, \$12.50 for each additional person. Kids under 12 are free.

These cabins can accommodate 10+ people.

For all cabins, you will need to bring your own bedding, towels, and bath items.

Pets are allowed in the cabins, however all pets must be leashed if out in the park.

Also available at Indian Lake Park ~

- 12 full hook-up RV sites, which rent for \$15.00 per night, plus tax. We do accept reservations for these sites. Check out is at 2:00 pm for these sites.
- 20+ electric only sites, which rent for \$10.00 per night, plus tax. These rent on a first come-first served basis.
- Numerous tent sites, renting for a fee of \$5.00 per tent, per night, plus tax. These rent on a first come-first served basis. Campers must register with the office prior to setting up.

Primitive tent sites are free every third weekend (Fri-Sun) of each month.

Stone Lodge rental is \$30.00 per day.  
Open Shelters rent for \$10.00 per day.



Coin operated showers are available to the public from April through October.

A 10% discount will be applied for all types of camping for stays of 7 days or more.

A 20% discount will be applied to stays of 30 days or more.

All prices are subject to sales tax.  
All prices are subject to change without notice.

Canoe and pedal boat rentals are available for \$4.00 per hour, or \$30.00 per day.

A 2-mile hiking/biking trail encompasses the lake, along with other small trails within the Park.



All campers must register at the Park office prior to use of the facilities. Camp sites will be assigned by the Park Managers.

Swimming is not allowed in the lake.

The speed limit within the Park is 15 mph.

Boat trailers must be parked in appropriate parking spaces.

Motorcycles and off road vehicles are prohibited on the trails.

Fires are only permitted in designated fire rings or areas.

Loud talking or noise is not permitted during sleeping hours.

Cleaning of dishes, utensils, and other items is not permitted at the drinking fountains.

Cleaning of game must be done outdoors and not inside cabins. Discarded parts must be placed in plastic bags and disposed of in the dumpster.

## Cabin Regulations

Check out after 11:00 am will result in a late fee charge.

There is absolutely no cleaning of fish or game in the cabins. There is a fish cleaning station at the dock on the lake.

The Park closes at 10:30 pm. Unregistered guests must leave the Park at that time.

Before Checking Out, Please Do the Following:

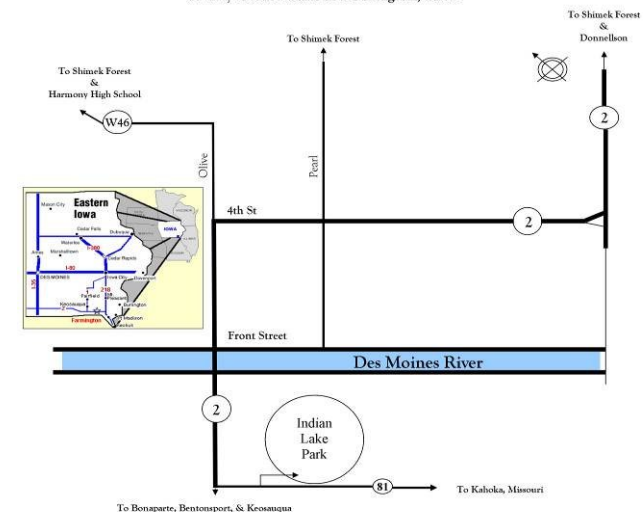
- ~ Wash, dry, and put away dishes
- ~ Sweep floors and shake out rugs
- ~ Put trash in the outside garbage cans
- ~ Unplug coffee maker and toaster
- ~ Turn off lights and lock doors
- ~ Remove all food from refrigerator
- ~ Report any problems or damages to the office

- ~ Summer: Turn off air conditioner
- ~ Winter: Turn heat down to 50 degrees

Future reservations may be denied if Park and Cabin regulations are not adhered to.
